



SPECIAL PERMIT 1019 REVISION NO. 5

This Special Permit is issued pursuant to the terms of Section 71.6(a) of the Canadian Transport Commission's "Regulations for the Transportation of Dangerous Commodities by Rail" to authorize the shipment of 1,1-Difluoroethane by rail in Canada, under conditions prescribed herein, and does not relieve any shipper or carrier from compliance with any requirement of the Commission's Regulations, except as specifically stated.

8. SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS


