Certificate of Registration

This is to certify that: Marison Company, 50-N. River Street, South Elgin Illinois U.S.A., pursuant to its application on file with Transport Canada has been granted the registration No. M16 in accordance with the provisions of Special Permit No. 3263 and section 25 of CAN/CSA B339-88 for the purpose of manufacturing compressed gas cylinders under the following terms and limitations:-

- 1) The cylinders shall be manufactured in complete accordance with Specifications 3A, 3AA or 3E, part 78 of the "Regulations for the Transportation of Dangerous Commodities by Rail", and as applicable with the requirements prescribed in the appendix "A" of this certificate.
- 2) The cylinders shall be in accordance with the drawings listed in the revised list dated 28-03-1990 and corresponding drawings and additional information provided with previous applications on file with this Directorate.
- 3) The manufacturing must be supervised by a duly authorized Independent Inspection Agency under an Inspection procedure conforming to the Specifications listed above or as authorized in Appendix "A" and filed with this Directorate.
- 4) The manufacturer's symbol to be marked on the cylinder shall be either "M16" or a symbol prescribed by the U.S. Department of Transportation or any other acceptable mark registered with this Directorate.
- 5) Within two (2) years after the Registration date of the certificate, a quality assurance manual shall be submitted to the Director. The manual shall indicate that the operations in the plant are in accordance with CAN3-Z299.3-85 or equivalent standard.

Not later than 20 days after any changes occur in the information submitted in support of the application, the holder shall advise this Directorate of any such changes.

Failure to comply with the above mentioned requirements or any applicable regulations may result in the suspension or revocation of this Certificate of Registration.

This Certificate of Registration shall expire on: April 1, 1995 or on such previous date as this Directorate may decide.

APPENDIX "A" TO CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION NO. M16

The following requirements apply to compressed gas cylinders made in complete accordance with specification 3AA, part 78 of the "Regulations for the Transportation of Dangerous Commodities by Rail";

- a) Except that the requirement for billets to be inspected after parting by the independent inspector is waived.
- b) The cylinders are of the Seamless Steel Billet pierced type in compliance with drawings D00137, D00138, D00140, D00143, D00155, D00160 and D00173 and additional information provided with the application on file with this Directorate.
- c) The manufacturer must keep a list of the serial numbers and symbols of all cylinders manufactured in this manner for at least fifteen years from the original test date.
